This meet is sanctioned by Swimming Queensland and all times (not including rule tolerance events) will be recognised as official qualifying times for all meets except for Australian and Queensland Championships.

Entry: Gates will open at 7.30am.

Time: Session 1: Warm up: 7.30am Start: 8.30am

Session 2*: Warm up: after session 1 **Start:** not before 11.00am

* Session 2 start times are subject to change and will be confirmed

Age: As at 14th September 2014

Eligibility: All swimmers must be registered as 'competitive' swimmers with SQ.

Events: This is a 'Development' Meet under SO's Competition Framework for Meets.

Rule tolerances only apply for designated events.

All events are open to multi-class swimmers

All SQ General Rules apply.

Heats and events may be combined on the day subject to Referee approval.

Timing: Semi-automatic timing system will be used; three timekeepers per lane.

Clubs nominate on the condition that they assist with timekeeping during the day.

Entries: Nominating clubs are responsible for ensuring that all competitors are registered with

SQ and that all details are current and correct. Entries must be submitted via your club's Carnival/Race Secretary (entries directly from individuals will not be accepted).

Entry fees: \$5.00/event for TM Entries (\$7.00/event for manual entries not sent through TM).

Close Date: 9pm, Saturday 30th August 2014. Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the three fastest swimmers in the age groups following:

Session 1 - 50m events: 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 yrs

- 200m IM: 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 yrs

- Rule Tolerance events: Participation ribbons only will be awarded

Session 2 - 100m events: 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 and over

200m IM: 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 and over

- 50m, 200m and 400m events: fastest three

Please note that swimmers must collect their medals/ribbons by the end of the meet.
