Date:	Sunday 7 th October 2018		
Time:	Morning Session (8-11 Years): Warm up 8:00am, Competition 9:00am sharp Afternoon Session (12 Years & Over): Will not start before 12 noon.		
Programs:	\$3.00 each – Will be available to purchase on arrival		
Age:	Age as at 7 th October 2018. Minimum age for competitors is 8 years.		
Eligibility:	Entry is open to all Swimming Queensland 'Competitive' registered swimmers who are a member of a club on the attached list who are allocated to this meet.		
Conditions of entry:	A Swimmer may nominate in any or all events in their age group. No swimming up is allowed. Nominations are accepted on the understanding that the nominating club has the responsibility to ensure that all competitors are registered with Swimming Queensland, date of birth is correct, and times entered are current. Clubs nominate on the condition that they provide timekeepers on the day.		
Timing:	Semi-automatic timing system will be used; three timekeepers per lane. Time keeping assignments for each club will be based on the percentage of each clubs' nominations per session. Lane assignments will be emailed to club secretaries prior to event and will be available on the day. Times recorded may be used as qualifying times for ALL other meets, including		
Entry cost:	\$7.00 per event. Entries will be via the Online Meet Entry system.		
Nominations:	Online nominations OPEN Wednesday 8 th August 2018. Follow this link Nominations CLOSES 23.59 EST Monday 24 th September 2018. Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted. NO DECK ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.		
Events:	As per the attached Schedule of Events. The meet will be conducted and run under SQ/SAL rules. One start rule will apply. All events will be swum as timed heats and placing given to the three fastest times in each age group. Referees decision is final. Minimum age of 11 years is required for Open Events; however, consideration may be made for swimmers who are 10 years old and will age up prior to the Brisbane Championships. Please email the Race Secretary for consideration.		
Awards:	Medals will be awarded to the three fastest placegetters in each age group. 50m – 8, 9, 10, and 11 years, 12, 13, 14, and 15 years & Over 100m – 8, 9, 10, and 11 years, 12, 13, 14, and 15 years & Over Fastest three placegetters overall will be awarded medals in the Open events - 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m
