**Venue:** Murray Evans Sports and Aquatic Centre  
4 Stephens Road, South Brisbane  
This well-equipped venue has kicker blocks at both ends and undercover seating for spectators and competitors.

**Entry:** Gates open at 7am  
Competitors, coaches and children under 12 years – Free  
Adults – \$4 each  
Programs – \$5.00 each (purchase on arrival)

**Time:** Warm-up from 7am – 8am  
Session 1: 8.15am competition starts  
Session 2: will commence after the completion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> warm up session.  
(time to be advised) Not before 12:00pm

**Age:** Age as at 10 February 2018 (minimum age is 8 years old).  
Minimum age for open events is 12 years of age.

**Eligibility:** Open to all swimmers registered with Swimming Queensland as 'Competitive' swimmers and who are members of the following affiliated clubs (as per Brisbane Swimming club allocation list): Acqua Rosa Clayfield, Albany Creek, Ashgrove, Ashgrove Tridents, Boondall, Brisbane Grammar, Brisbane Jets, Carina Leagues CJ's, Churchie, Clayfield Aquatics, Commercial, Craigslea, Eagle Junction, Everton Park, Ferny Hills, Healthstream, Ithaca Creek, Newmarket Racers, Rackley (Central), Rackley (East), Samford, Somerville House, Stafford, The Gap, The Swim Academy and Wilston.

**Conditions:** Nominations are accepted on the understanding that the nominating club has the responsibility to ensure that all competitors are registered with Swimming Queensland, date of birth is correct & times entered are current.

Clubs nominate on the condition that they are to supply timekeepers on the day.

Lane assignments will be emailed to clubs' race secretaries prior to event and will be available on day of event.
- Events:** As per attached Schedule of Events. The meet will be conducted and run under the rules and with permission of Swimming Queensland.
- Entries:** Only online meet entries will be accepted at this meet.

- Session 2: Ribbons will be awarded to the three (3) fastest times in the following age groups: 12 Years, 13 Years, 14 Years, & 15 Years & Over for 50 & 100 metre events. Medals will be awarded to the three (3) fastest times in all other events.
